After a picnic lunch, we will travel to Beaufort, NC and board a ferry to Carrot Island, part of the Rachel Carson Reserve.

We will spend the afternoon exploring the island trail and learning about mudflats, uplands, and salt marshes, and if we're lucky, we'll get to see some of the birds, fish, invertebrates, and horses that call the island home. When the sun gets too hot, we'll cool off with a swim in the sound. On our way home, we will stop for dinner at the Sanitary Fish Market and Restaurant in Morehead City.

Northeast District 4-H Agricultural Science Camp

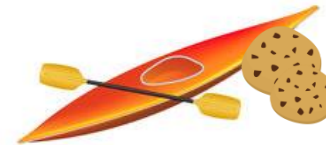

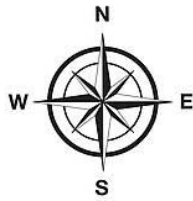


All About the Outdoors: Wildlife, Archery, and Orienteering
