Refunds cannot be issued *unless* the event is cancelled due to low enrollment (less than 6 participants). **NO PHONE, FAX, OR MAIL-IN REGISTRATION will be accepted.**

(Hosted by Camden & Currituck Counties)

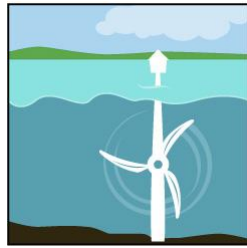

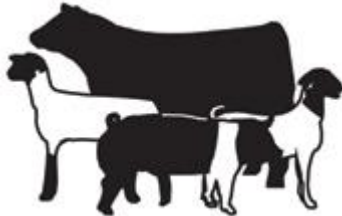

Livestock Farms Tour

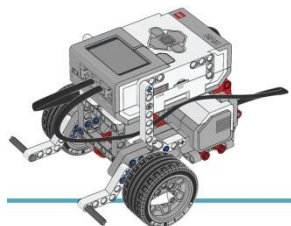

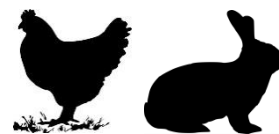
Location: East Carolina Livestock Arena
