4-H Summer Fun is an educational program of the North Carolina Cooperative Extension, Edgecombe County 4-H Program. The program runs throughout the summer with educational and fun opportunities for youth ages 5-18. Activities are open to ages specific to the age appropriateness of the activities. *NOTE: Youth must be 5 to 18 years of age as of January 1, 2018 and you DO NOT have to be in 4-H to participate.*
