

Salt Dough Ornaments

Supplies

- salt dough (ingredients below)
- rolling pin
- ruler, to measure dough thickness
- egg shape cutter
- spatula
- straw, for making holes
- parchment-paper covered baking sheets
- spray or acrylic paint
- paint pens, optional
- clear coat sealer, optional
- Twine or ribbon

Ingredients

- 1 cup flour
- 1/2 cup salt
- 1/2 cup water

Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 250F
2. Combine all ingredients into a medium size bowl
3. Stir ingredients until a dough forms
 - a. Knead the dough using your hands to make it smoother, if needed
4. Put the new dough on a flat surface and using a rolling pin, roll it out to about 1/4 in thick
5. Use cookie cutter to cut the dough into fun shapes
6. Use a straw to add a hole to the shape.
7. Put parchment paper on a cookie sheet and place your cut out shapes (ornaments) on the sheet.
8. Bake the ornaments for 2 hours at 250F
9. With adult supervision, remove pan from the oven, wait for them to completely cool
10. They are now ready to be painted and decorated!
11. Loop the ribbon through the hole and knot. They are ready to hang and display
