

## Elmer's Slime Kit

### Supplies Included:

- 1 Bottle of Elmer's White School glue (6 oz)
- Baking Soda (½ Teaspoon in a ziplock bag)
- Contact Solution (containing boric acid)
- Glitter

### Instructions: How to Make Slime with Contact Solution

- 1) Get a bowl to mix your slime ingredients in.
- 2) Pour your entire 6 oz Elmer's glue into the bowl.
- 3) Add your baking soda and mix in thoroughly. (OPTIONAL) Also add 1 TBSP or more (up to ½ cup) of water here if you want a stretchier slime. You can also add glitter to your slime if desired.
- 4) Slowly add in your contact lens solution containing boric acid. Add it in slowly and mix if possible so that you can adjust and ensure you do not add too much. You may not need the full amount so take this step slowly.
- 5) Now mix until your slime forms and begins to harden. Take it out and knead, knead, knead. You may be surprised how much you need to knead to really make the slime form. If it's not the desirable consistency, keep kneading. If you find it still to be too sticky, add a little bit of lotion or baby oil to your hands.
