

Make your own Classic Playdough

Recipe from NC Museum of History, adapted from CarolinaCountry.com

Test out your creative art skills by using playdough to make a picture, sculpture or imprint. You can use this recipe to make many different colors and let your imagination run wild with all the things you can make. This is a little messy but that's just half the fun right?

Materials

- 1 Cup of water
- 1 Tablespoon of Vegetable Oil
- ½ Cup of Salt
- 1 Tablespoon of Cream of Tartar (to make your playdough last 6months)
- Food Coloring, any color
- 1 Cup of Flour

Directions

1. Measure out all of the ingredients.
2. Combine water, oil, salt, cream of tartar and food coloring (all ingredients except flour) in a saucepan
3. Heat mixture until warm.
4. Remove from heat and add flour.
5. Stir and then knead until smooth.
6. Store in an airtight container or freezer bag.
