Covid Rules/Limitations

- All attendees must wear a mask in the show barn.
- According to the governor's order, no spectators are allowed, requesting that only exhibitor's & guardians attend.
- Livestock will need to shown off trailers, no small pens available in the barn.
- The Governor's order requires that the show be broadcast live, or recorded and played later (online). You must allow your child to be videoed in order to participate.
- Everyone on the premises will be asked to social distance and stay within their family units. Disposable masks will be provided or the participants may bring their own. "Mask" can be any face covering that covers the nose and mouth.

Concessions

• We will not have a food truck this year, but will take whole pizza orders 2 hours prior to show time. Drinks available.

Show Rules

- 1. Showmanship age divisions based on exhibitor's age as of January 1, 2020.
- 2. Youth must show their own animal for showmanship.
- 3. Shows are open to ages 5-18.
- 4. All animals must meet NC health requirements. No sick animals will be allowed to show!
- 5. Decisions of judge are final.
- 6. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.
- 7. Disputes will be handled by the show committee and circuit boards.
- 8. Each exhibitor can show 2 animals from each species.
- 9. All animals must have a form of identification (tags, tattoo, etc.)

Goats & Sheep

- 1. All animals must have a scrapie tag.
- 2. All horn tips must be dulled and/or blunt.
- 3. Must have all baby teeth the day of the show.
- 4. No bucks allowed.
- 5. Market classes will be divided by weight.

Heifers

- 1. All animals must be halter broke, unruly heifers will be asked to leave show ring.
- 2. Heifers must be born on or after November 1, 2018.
