

Lenoir County Additional Rules

In order to participate at the Lenoir County Fair, the following requirements must be met:

- All participants in the show ring must wear a mask.
- All participants waiting in the make up area must wear a mask.
- Spectators at the show ring will be asked to wear a mask and will be required to stand off the railing (not leaning into the ring).
- The Governor's order requires that the show be broadcast live, or recorded and played later (online). You must allow your child to be videoed in order to participate
- Everyone on the premises will be asked to social distance and stay within their family units.

Disposable masks will be provided or the participants may bring their own. "Mask" can be any face covering that covers the nose and mouth.

The Lenoir County Fair Association has adopted these requirements as recommended by NC State University. Therefore, any individual who hosts a livestock show on their premises is required to abide by these requirements.

The above requirements will also be mandated at the NC Mountain State Fair Shows, NC State Fair Shows, and any other event where N.C. Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services or NC State Extension employees are involved.
