2. A current school transcript and if applicable, a listing of SAT or ACT scores to be included in the scholarship package
3. Three letters of reference; one based on academic achievement, one based on accomplishments of extracurricular activities, and one based on 4-H livestock work (at least 1 academic based reference- ex. current teacher/instructor). **No Edgecombe County Extension staff member will be eligible to write a letter of recommendation for this scholarship, please use 4-H volunteers, etc.**
4. Applicant may attach computer generated information for the questions in the application with the exception of the essay.
5. Include essay in the scholarship package (limit to 3 pages, handwritten by applicant).

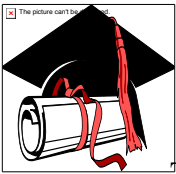

Edgecombe County 4-H Livestock Scholarship

This 4-H Scholarship will be awarded to a participating 4-H'er in the following grades **11th, 12th or entering 1st year college freshman**, still meeting the requirement of 4-H age eligibility. The applicant must be involved in the 4-H Livestock Show & Sale to be eligible for this scholarship. In addition, this applicant must be planning to attend college (2-year or 4-year school of their choice) beyond high school. Recipients of this scholarship **must** be enrolled and provide proof of acceptance, in a formal education program beyond high school to receive scholarship funds.

This scholarship is a "one-time" award and will be given jointly to the individual and their chosen institution of higher learning. This is not a cash award.

Regulations:

1. Awarded to Edgecombe County 4-H'ers that are involved in the 4-H Livestock Program (Grades 11, 12 or 1st year entering college freshman, of 4-H age eligibility).
2. Forms must be submitted prior to **5:00 p.m. on June 1, 2021** to be considered.
3. Applications are available from Edgecombe County Cooperative Extension Office, 201 Saint Andrew Street, Tarboro, NC 27886 or request an electronic copy (via email).
4. It is not necessary to attend a four year college or university to be eligible but enrollment in a formal continuing education program is required.
5. 4-H'ers must have been enrolled in a 4-H livestock project to be eligible.
6. An essay is required. Topic will be:
"The impact the 4-H Livestock Program has made in my life"
7. A current school transcript and if applicable, a listing of SAT, PSAT or ACT scores to be included in the scholarship package
8. Three letters of recommendation. One must be academic based (example- teacher or instructor). References must be received by **June 1, 2021**.

NOTE: No recommendation letters will be given by Edgecombe County Extension staff for this scholarship.
